Statement of Purpose

- PSM is the Party of democratic Romanian left.

General Statements

- 701 a) Political conceptions of PSM are rooted to
 the philosophy and experience of the socialist,
 working class democratic Romanian and inter-
 national movement and finds its concrete ex-
 701 pressions in a coherent ensemble of socialist, demo-
 cratic humanistic, social justice bound, equal rights
 and defense of human dignity ideas. National
 701 Creativeness and strong working class solidarity
 will be also our goals to achieve.
- b) PSM grants, together with all authentic demo-
 201 cratic political forces, the right to free organiza-
 tion and association, to open expression of political
 201 religious, philosophical conceptions, in order to achieve
 establishment of morals and reciprocal respect, fa-
 601 vourable to dialogue and constructive cooperation
 among all patriotic forces national forces.
- c) PSM rejects and condemns any kind of
 201 dictatorship and totalitarian regime, any kind
 201 of social and national suppression, any kind
 201 of extremism and ~~exclusion~~ discrimination
 201 any breaking of human rights, altogether with
 201 militating for restricted and limited through
 415 ~~the~~ means economic oppression and human

alienation.

202 d) PSM militates for establishment and development
601 of fundamental values of democracy - freedom, equality,
justice, solidarity, assuming to serve, through its
policy, the main interests of Romanian people on its
way to progress, civilization and culture, to defend
109 territorial integrity, independence and sovereignty of
Romania.

401 e) PSM stands for transition to the market economy,
4013 various kinds of property, real social protection, growth
503 and modernization of national economy, increasing
410 productiveness, efficiency and work discipline, expansion
410 of economic external relationships and rights
407 firm
701 against unemployment, inflation and social-economic
instability.

414 f) PSM is preoccupied with development of science,
502 arts, culture, major issues of education and
502 502 public health, protection of family, persons and
506 504 categories in disgrace, establishing necessary
706 work conditions for work, education and rest,
503 salary according to skills, effort and results, res-
412 tricted discrepancy of income, assuring a
412 dignifying life for the whole population.

606 g) According to history and specific traditions,
broad social basis, fundamental features in
ideologic and political issues, ideals and goals
PSM has, in the actual political landscape
its own, ^{distinct} important position, ~~as a~~ ^{as a}
mediator for equilibrium and stability in social
and political life, ~~as~~ ^{as} legitimate representative
701 of large working class mass, ~~giving~~ ^{giving}
202 impulse to the democratic evolution of the country.

606 h) PSM stands for cooperation with other parties,
professional organizations, all democratic and
progressive forces of the country. Also, PSM is open

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to cooperation with advanced forces, socialist movements, communist, workers', democratic and progressive movements in the whole world.

2. Historical legitimacy

a) PSh assumes representation and continuity of legitimate

70/ progressive traditions in socialist, workers', democratic movements in our country, that gave new dimensions to the ~~19th~~ century-lasting Romanian people's ~~fight~~ struggle for national freedom and social justice, for a better life, progress, unity and independence of our country.

70/ b) The Workers' and Socialist movement in Romania, ~~which was the first of its kind in the Balkans~~ formed in the 19th century, of clear left democratic feature, was rapidly recognized home and abroad. After Reunification in 1918, half a million members were active

70/ which meant that it was one of the most powerful ~~movements in Europe~~ of the time. All over its history, this movement has fought for the working class interests, better

70/ work and life conditions, participated together with peasants class, intellectuals and other advanced forces in foundation of the national unitary state.

60/ Acting as a new, progressive agent in social-economic and political evolution of Romania.

70/ Sources of conflicts and fractures within our socialist movement were, starting with the 3rd decade in 20th century, the evil influence and presence of fatidic negative policy of the 3rd Communist International (Comintern) supported by opportunistic elements inside Comintern. Succeeded in splitting the movement and dragging it ~~away~~ to ~~paths~~ alien to national interests and socialist ideal.

f) Objectively reconsidering, without preconceptions, the convulsive ~~many~~ evolution of the Socialist, communist, democratic and workers' movement in Romania PSM assumes its positive features, categorically rejecting alienation and errors, abuse and illegal ~~and~~ acts which led, to some extent and in different ways, to dissolution of socialist and humanist ideals, to breaking the laws of democracy, human rights, to establishment of voluntarism and subjectivism, and, in social practice, to absolutist forms of dictatorship and totalitarianism.

201 ~~firmly~~ rejecting any utopian views and political rigidity, ~~for~~ Stalinian practice which disgraced the noble ideals of socialism. PSM also rejects total ~~en-~~slavement and repudiating everything the Romanian people created, ~~the~~ ^{the} their arms and minds, ~~that~~ ^{that}

2051 ~~accept~~ calumny and persecution of those who, acting for the realization of an ideal, contributed to increase of national wealth and national prestige. PSM will continue analysis of errors in close or remotest which is a moral duty and a prime condition of its credibility, to obtain a fair result of the evaluation of all achievements in this period and getting adequate solutions to avoid further errors.

g) Historical experience shows that in decisive moments of our destiny - invasions and divisions, dictates and dictatorships, aggressions, social suppression and nationalist passions - the Romanian people found its existential support for survival in this part of the world, through ~~solid~~ unity and cohesion of its sons, placing national interests above political ~~different interests~~ ethnic, religious interests and loyal cooperation of all progressive and patriotic forces of the country.

PSM will, therefore act in this spirit ~~for~~ to develop
606 a true reconciliation of all progressive forces, towards
701 the reconstruction of the socialist movement / realization of
701 a large democratic front of work and creation, on a
601 generally loyal national consensus.

3. Social basis and national frame

503 complex problems of social and individual contemporary
life.

b) PSM, without mixing up the Romanian Communist Party
with the Ceausescu dictatorship and its negative
effects, recognizes as members all those ~~former~~ members
2051 of the Communist Romanian Party, faithful to their
list ideals and ~~dedications~~ wishing to adhere
to its Statute and Programme and actively partici-
pate in transforming Romania into a real demo-
cratic country, promoting human ~~and~~ freedom
and dignity. We rely upon the fact that the
2051 immense majority of former members of the PCR and
similar youth, women, union organizations, worked honestly

competently, in good faith for socialist and humanistic ideals
and built this country, through incredible humiliation and
needs together with the rest of the population and joined
into the popular revolt against dictatorship, together with

4. Theoretical ~~Principles~~ ^{Principles}. Receptiveness for transformation and renewal.

a) PSM is founded on an open doctrine based, in scientific and progressive, ~~including~~ ^{built on} scientific modern

conquests in human knowledge over real world phenomena viewed in their contextual and historical evolution, in a dynamic and all wide conception, regarding all material and spiritual factors determining evolution of human personality, the whole society progress.

b) Permanently open to novelty, advanced and high value ⁱⁿ universal circuit of ideas, PSM ^{firmly} rejects ^{issues}

20/ all dogmatism andolute thinking, conceptual and ideologic exclusivism, any tendency in establishing an unique doctrine or ideology, dominant and hegemony by active which leads to theoretical and spiritual rigidity, anachronism and ideologic mortification.
4/5 PSM recovers all good ideas in marxism, as well as all scientific conceptions, progressive, human and universal, and rejects utopic views or views ingering basis of democracy or human rights.

c) Assuming experience and wisdom of the international socialist and democratic movement
503 PSM also sets on a central position the Romanian socialist tradition. PSM will practice universal

20/ moral precepts which allow progress of human being in freedom, equality and dignity, man, with his individual and social life, actively and equally involved into home and international processes, animated by the spirit of fairness and solidar
503 of acceding to the highest cultural ~~deft~~ levels and practice of a ~~useful~~ work useful to society to get his well fare and dignity, represents the central, unifying point in our party's policy.

PSM considers that ~~which is incompatible with its~~

606 a) According to PSM the main request now is a united
effort towards solving the major problems of the country.

606 e) In this view, PSM will cooperate with left and
center-left parties and will ~~gradually~~ establish to some
extent, cooperation relationship with other progressive

601 forces, solidary to the whole Romanian population in its
504 effort to get to well-being and democracy.

202 PSM, recognizing the evil in internal conflicts
militates ~~against~~ for giving up labels, intimidation
and ~~other~~ attempts to accuse various parties of
2051 evil in the past, in order to get a smoother political
climate, necessary to the progress of the country.

PSM promotes realizing and supporting every action
403 leading to: economic revival, real reform, eradica-
tion of the ~~great~~ fear for losing the industrial ca-
701 pacities and massive unemployment, equili-
414 brum of commercial and payments balances,
701 total absorption of labour disponibilities, real
503 social protection, stop the inflation and avoid-
412 ing its evil effects, no discrimination
503 being allowed. ~~in these~~

1. Social market economy

a) PSM considers that, in the process of reali-
403 zing the social market economy, public admini-
stration plays an important part with re-
gards to macro-economic directions and so-
cial protection. PSM states that turning back
415 to a free capitalist market, ~~the~~ either primi-
tive or classic, would be anachronistic for
Romania.

but a market would create contradictions and ~~chaos~~
and incredible social convulsions, unbelievable
differences and distortions to micro and macro systems
445 in both economic and social fields, with unpredictable
effects for the general balance needed and getting out
from the crisis. The free market generates, together with
some elements necessary to progress, huge negative conse-
445 quences to social life, pauperizing the working class,
strongly setting apart rich and poor people, jeopardizing
national interests, particularly in case of small
countries where the economic force is ~~is~~ weaker.
403 In order to attenuate these effects we came to the
idea of correcting them through emphasizing the
part of the public administration in the process.
The social market economy corresponds to one ideal
403 of a harmonic society, built on the principles of
solidarity, contemporary socialist doctrine and
democratic leftist ideas. We are persuaded that
transition to a social market economy is more
403 suitable for Romania now, than establishing
a "free market", either ~~perhaps~~ classical or
(neo-liberal).

b) Transition to a social market economy
403 restates the principles of the reform. We insist
that the reform ~~should~~ brings no type of capi-
talist economic structures, according to the
Romanian economic ones: in 1938, 1947 or any
other contemporary pattern; still, we don't
want Romania to return to the supercentral-
403 ized, bureaucratic structures either. We
think the social market economy is fully
compatible with us, as it does not hinder
403 autonomy of economic agents, competition,
other and request, etc.

c) Transition to social market economy is an objective necessity and is not to be credited to any political game. It is mainly a correction to the errors made by the super centralized, bureaucratic economic system and releases the creative process, based on a production related to market request, market exchanges, the market being recognized as the only structure capable to realize fair values in economy. Social market economy eliminates the chaos generated by the free ups and downs of offer and demand and creates a relatively stable equilibrium and dynamic. It is also a better performance type of economic system, a better alternative to neoclassics or "socialist" types, adding social justice to the basic principles of liberty and competition.

2. Public Administration - a main economic coordinator

a) To our opinion, the public administration, as a representative of the whole nation, must assure co-ordination of interests with the economic agents, in order to fulfil the main economic emergencies. If transition is freely achieved, the uncontrolled mechanisms of the free market lead to a long lasting, painful process of dismantling the whole industrial system, which means that Romania will never ever integrate to the European economic system, to the international distribution as well as to create the two poles of rich and poor people.

503 b) We think that the public administration must assume the responsibility of social protection for all the people in this country. / According to our views the public administration is an economic agent, efficiently using the free market mechanisms, still correcting disequilibrium and directing the interests of all the other economic agents. /

412 c) Under the circumstances of the social market economy, the public administration, together with other economic and social agents, ~~represent the~~ represent the function of redistributing the national income, assuring both ~~the~~ progress and social equity. / It is the only way to give equal chances

412 to all the citizens, without any material or social discrimination. / We will act for the public administration to turn from a bureaucratic inefficient

412 system to a really competitive economic agent, permanently generating well fare for the population. / According to our conceptions, the public administration

412 is to direct and set rules for the whole ~~man~~ ^{economy} ~~process~~ process / Through economic and financial mechanisms, it is its duty to stimulate and support economy in the situation of manifested

412 social, economic and political pluralism. / Under the circumstances, every citizen turns from

401 the position of an administrative element, ~~which~~ passively obeying to orders, into an active element for the economic process, all his creative functions involved into the country's well fare. / In absence of the ~~the~~ fair judge the public administration represents, the free market economy may lead to total annihilation of the very principles of modern social construction / ~~the~~ of democratic liberties and political pluralism. /

3) Plural Property Forms - Mixed Type Economy

4013

PSM states that the social market economy is fully compatible to plural property forms.

4013

a) Historically speaking, the way of property towards great patrimonial conglomerates in the ~~economic~~ and social evolution, through various forms such as: associative, cooperative, corporative, no poles, public ~~or~~ public and private - mixed forms.

4013

The great property lives together with small and medium property, usually private property (partnership type). The market assures the competition for all these forms and their importance vary according to economic cyclic phases and economic efficiency requirements.

4013

b) PSM recognizes the importance and necessary existence of private property, whose dimensions are not preset, but established according to the free circulation of concrete, economic and social elements, expressing and measuring its importance in ~~the~~ real conditions. Although, PSM accepts and supports private property, we have for a moderate rhythm of privatization, prudent rejecting this campaign, similar to the nationalization one in 1948, which could lead to a severe economic handicap, new sufferings for a major part of the population and severe social convulsions.

c) In Romania, social property was created through desperate efforts and sacrifice of the people who thus ~~are~~ ^{are} important owners of the national

413 Privatization is, therefore, both theoretically and in
practice, an expropriation act. The question is if this
413 issue is rational, necessary and to what extent. The
world's experience ~~shows~~ ^{proves} that public property
413 is not obligatorily inefficient and unprofitable.
We are convinced that solutions will come to re-
deem some public enterprises and stop priva-
413 tization for privatization's sake. Without any
attempt to diminish the ~~part~~ importance of pri-
413 vatization, PSM thinks that the main economic
criterion is efficiency in administration of public
413 All left alone, privatization and ~~the~~ various forms
of property, essential to the market economy, comp-
413 titum and free initiative are subordinated to ec-
onomic administration. If we want to realize
efficient transition to the market economy we must
413 make an efficient use of all forms of property.
We stand for privatization for ~~the~~ ^{the} extent of
413 creating associative forms in industry and trade. We
are not against establishing private enterprises
413 ~~for~~ joint ventures included. Privatization must create
the first issues for realizing mainly mixed property
as a basis for the new Romanian society. Public
property, directed and administered according
413 to the market economy criteria and has to occupy
the key positions in economy. PSM considers that
during the privatization process, privatization, national-
413 izing and standard of life should not lower
but grow. This goal will not be achieved through
413 robbing and devastating the public property or bri-
tal transfer, but through creating new private en-
413 terprises in all economic fields. Privatization must
be figured as a long, many stages process, as a
413 result of the transition to the social market econ-
omy.

8- Privatization must be shaped as a supplementary source for development, creating new jobs and not for making way to a rapid enrichment, through speculation and theft, through an increased number of unemployed. PSM will stand for a strategy of this process, based on economic rather than political criteria, to assure maintenance and development of production relationships among all kinds of economic agents.

4012 e) PSM supports the right ~~of~~ ^{to} associations for the private agents, as associations and cooperatives will get a better position in modern economy. The Cooperatorist Romanian movement is based on an important tradition and we will militate for its integration into the international movement of the kind.

4013 - no form of property should be seen as a dogma. According to our views, crooks, racketeers, profiteers are no ideal or specific elements for the market economy. The social market economy we want establish is based on competition, performance and loyalty which only the rule of law can grant. There is no use in replacing a wrong system with another even worse one. Therefore we stand for realistic solutions in privatization and effective social protection of the working class, with a lively ideal of all equal chances and rights society, without a discrimination based on other criteria than personal talents and work. Rapid privatization may lead to some rapacious actions which will deprive the ordinary people - peasants, workers and intellectuals - of the collective goods and values they created during the last 50 years.

f) ~~Max~~ Protection for work and its results, ~~the~~ the well fare of the working class, its present and future destiny are severely ~~injured~~ ^{allegate} nowadays, therefore nobody is allowed to ~~injure~~ a worker, abuse him physically or mentally, for his fear to lose his position and social role, for his nostalgic attachment to the socialist revolution era, for his conservative or looking back attitude, for his longing for the easy past egalitarian views. The success of the Reform lies in concrete issues, capable to soothe everyone, revive his optimism and confidence in his work's usefulness.

g) PSM stands for a long while mixed property stage in Romanian society, in order to assure social and individual progress. The national ^{economic} and social interests cannot be privatized. To our opinion, the mixed economy presents some advantages such as: assuring coexistence of various forms of property, maintaining public property in basic economic fields and public administration for national interest industry, based on modern management, allows economic revival for big enterprises which correspond to the need of concentrating the capital, allows individual property and other forms of associative property granting right for it; assures harmonious relationship between social and individual property.

To our opinion, the right to exist must be conquered by any form of property, through its own adaptability and degree of resistance to survive to competition rules.

4. Flexible and modern planning

a) PSM is deeply concerned with the need of creating a strategy for the use of the nation's resources.

resource, coordinated investment programmes and attract-
404 ing foreign capital to Romania. We think that a quarter
of the bare national income should be used for rein-
404 vesting the investments.

b) PSM ~~states~~ stands for a combination of ~~different~~
404 directing and liberal principles in economic man-
agement, the only guarantee for success!

c) According to other countries' experience, there
404 is absolutely necessary to do a proper econo-
mic planning. PSM firmly rejects excessively cen-
tralized, subjective-voluntary, ~~possibly~~ unrealistic

404 economy, based on wrong ideologic principles. We
see no reason for abandoning flexible planning
in macrosystems, optimizations, propnosis and other

404 worldwide accepted means. The market by itself
can assure no ways of development and progress

Therefore, PSM wants to draw a vast plan for
404 the transition period and just transition period
altogether, and appeals to all technicians and

404 specialists willing to help to the getting out from
the errors of the past and to apply their dispo-

404 saries that ~~were~~ were taken into consideration
before. Their participation will assure a modern
basis to our economy.

d) PSM considers that reestablishing the balance
404 between offer and request is the duty of the public
administration which will assure the development
of competitive, demopolized markets. Of course,

404 Lemnorys functions and degree of ~~the~~ proper
in planning will be drawn according to specific
forms of property.

5. A Strategy for Industrial Development

- a) PSM considers that industrialization of Romania corresponded to a ~~necessary~~ necessity for development with a weakly developed country at that particular moment. Before the war, Romania was in a back position in Europe and couldn't assure proper development for its economy. We highly appreciate the Romanian people's effort in establishing the ^{existing} industrial system. The industrial map of Romania cannot be denied and responds to the aspirations and desire of all enlightened minds that worked for getting our country out of ~~the~~ its backwards motion. Only a few years ago, our industrial results were international quoted. The Romanian industry, although a little out of the technological progress nowadays, still follows the ways of the international technical progress. The opinions of some political lobbies in our country, according to which we should abandon heavy industry and concentrate upon agriculture and tourism, prove only a serious misunderstanding of fundamental progressive notions and pull the country to a third rate statute in the world. These conceptions are really out of date, antihistorical and anti national. PSM states that anybody opposing to the idea of industrialization ~~is~~ stands against rational progressive tendencies of the country.
- b) We stand for further industrialization of the country based on the social market economy principles and new technology applied to less profitable industries.

We can't allow the Romanian industry to get scattered in small entities, and let her stay apart from the international system, which, we all know, is made of great ^{industrial} conglomerates, dominant for their respective economic systems. / by policy going against industrialization is declared by us, as anti-national. /

c) We stand for bringing new technology, competitive ness and quality standards to Romania. /

d) PSD appeals to the working class, intellectuals, peasants, everybody that participated in constructing, through his personal work, to the industrial system's realization, to defend this great victory, until it is too late. /

Because forces, enemies to national interests want to pull down, ~~and~~ providing some false reasons, the Romanian industry and thus eliminating us as a potential rival in the circumstances of the market economy. / Romania has all disinclinations to become a strong, industrial country and must not be reduced to play the part of the European Cinderella. / We will militate together with those attached to the results of their hard work for the development of rational and fair strategies referring to ways of progress for the national industry, a main source for labour also and better standards of life. /

6. Agriculture and Food Industry

a) PSD stands for intensive and modern agriculture, a main issue in its strategy for economic progress in Romania. Agriculture must be prioritized as it is the main source for supplies for both population and industry and for exports. /

Of course, its development will be related to the urban
and services ones, in order to integrate it ra-
pidly into the social market economy features.

b) ~~According to~~ According to present and future
national interests, agricultural assets and forests
are to ~~be paid special~~ be paid special
attention, no matter whose property they are.
The public administration must stimulate and
provide motivations for the farming-workers to work
all the land, no matter whose property it is.
Any direct or indirect operation over the land
must work for its improvement, not for its
spoiling and must concentrate in the protection
of the environment.

c) PSM is aware of the great importance, inter-
nationally proved, of the great agricultural mini-
strys. Therefore we stand for a fair dimensioning
of the agricultural property in conditions of inha-
bitant flexibility and innovation, efficiency and ~~profitability~~
profitability. We will promote and protect small
private property in those areas where great ones
cannot be economically motivated, as we believe
that scattered little farms, with small economic po-
tential, reduce progress in agriculture.

If PSM respects and defends the right for property
and supports individual farms and their turning into pro-
ductive units. Taking into consideration that,
because of the competition characteristic to
the market economy, some farmers will go
bankrupt, we must figure out a system for
reintegrating them into some other productive ac-
tivities. We also stand for cooperatives and asso-
ciations which provide right to property for their
members.

- These farms are suitable for old people ~~and~~ recently
 402 allotted and unable to work in the fields, people with
 no access to property, taking their chances to a decent
 work and life, through their work in associations.
- 403 Our party will respect the farmers' individual
 choice for one or another form of property.
- 413 e) We support maintenance and strengthening of
 public agricultural units which can provide a large
 amount of supplies. Thus influencing the prices.
 The mechanical ^{public} units must supply technical
 413 device, under favourable conditions, to all farmers
 in the area and, therefore, they must keep under
 public control. We also stand for a complex service
 system, impossible to set without public funds and
 413 public employees' work, to supply fertilizers, research
 etc for the farming units.
- 411 PSD considers that it is highly necessary to
 find proper solutions to utilize the great number of
 specialists who developed our agriculture in spite
 411 of the enormous difficulties they meet. There is a
 tendency to under estimate these people, very in
 411 portance to the progress of agriculture. We have to militate
 for their participation in modern agricultural life.
- 411 f) The public administration will have to act for
 412 attenuation and annulment if possible, of the
 evil effects of application of the "Land Law" reflects.
 The public administration will see to it becoming
 412 an efficient partner and manager altogether, about
 investments, prices granted, credits and insurance
 against risks and uncertainty. We also promote
 412 protection for the consumers through creating public
 food stocks ~~the~~ which will be delivered in
 case of calamities.

411 g) We stand for a modern food industry, capable to make good use of our agricultural potentials.

108 h) PSM stands for a coherent and flexible policy with agriculture, rising Romania up to the European Standards. The public administration is the only source for realizing these goals; through governmental or non governmental organizations, the public administration will have to involve in new management and marketing consulting, inside and outside trade, in order to be able to face international competition for our agricultural products.

411 Romanian villages will be modernized through supplying them with roads of access, service systems, shops, transports, etc. This goal must be achieved also in order to redeem the peasant's dignity, as a ~~maker~~ ^{producer} of the bread of ^{national} ~~the~~ ^{unity} ~~history~~ ^{tradition} and language keeper and always defender of the national integrity.

7. Foreign Trade

407 a) PSM militates for expansion of Trade relationships with all the countries in the world. We will take special care for our relations with the countries in our geographical area, which ~~assured~~ ^{assured} in the last 20 years, a proper distribution of economic ~~status~~ ^{directions} and developed specific relationship with us. We will also favorize developing of relations with countries in the West. We are against the theory of comparative costs which wants to maintain the world parted in two parts, one poor and 407 the other one wealthy.

5/ We are definitely against those political Roman-
 109 nian and other forces that want our country
 to become a "modern" colony of the ^{west} European
 system. We are against losing our independence
 and sovereignty, as old-fashioned as these con-
 109 ceptions might appear to "internationalist" modern
 views. We don't want the "valer" plan we have
 109 rably rejected 30 years before, to be accepted now,
 under other circumstances and shapes.

c) PSM will support any Trade relationship which
 406 does not lead to transfer abroad of any part
 of the national income created in Romania.
 d) Foreign trade and particularly exports will have
 407 to be stimulated as a source for imports, as we
 are against the burden of public debts. We are a-
 gainst liberalizing foreign Trade, due to com-
 406 parative costs or "lining up" to international prices
 in order to get protection for our economy and natu-
 ral currency.

c) Exports will be financially stimulated, no matter
 403 what kind of trade agents are involved. Liberaliza-
 tion will gradually be allowed, according to
 412 fulfilment of competition standards by the Roma-
 nian products and the situation in ~~national~~ outside
 payment balance.

f) PSM will promote tourism which is highly
 411 suitable for development in our beautiful country.
 We will particularly stimulate cooperation in
 407 bank and insurance system, transports and
 communications, ~~etc~~ software, etc.

8. Finance - Budget Policy

412 a) PSM stands for a policy in financial field
 to set directions for the national economy

412 This policy will see to the proper balance between income
and cost in order to stop inflation. As long as offer
of native products is low, the public administration
412 should keep control over the prices and fight against
speculations, corruption, illegal and dishonest means
304 of getting rich.

b) Tax policy will have to protect the working class
701 through increased minimal income exempt of tax
and progressive tax rate. The budget can't rate
503 on the income of little people; the big profits must
have to ~~deliberate~~ provide the public budget with necessary
503 funds. Also, basic product must be exempt of
taxes or subject to lower ones. We stand for
303 saving the public resource, particularly through
reducing administrative cost.

c) PSM considers that the public administration
is to be entirely or partially involved in national
412 interest investments, profitable in long time, such
as: raw materials, energy, top technology, flats
constructions, economic infrastructures, etc. Public
412 economic agents have to be supported by public
funds and not pulled down through bankrupts
in order to allow foreign capital to get them for
nothing.

d) Credit policy has to be related to economic stability
402 and revival. Moderate interest policy is very
402 suitable as the "expensive money" may cause delay
the reform. Low interest for farming loans
703 are also recommendable.
e) The efforts in currency policies will be directed
414 to assure balance between income and ha-
currency payments, through promoting export
tourism and services.

414 1) After these ⁷³ conditions above are fulfilled, we
may start to think of conversion of the "Leu". We
must be very careful about it, as, while we are devoid
414 of strong economic potentials and hard currency
reserve, the "Leu" will still collapse in international
exchange. Therefore, we state that no external
public aid can help us, but our own national
work, products, quality and prices of those pro-
406 ducts on the foreign markets.

iii Social Policy

503 PSM is convinced of the fact that the social
policy is no ~~new~~ effect of economic development
but a start to it, which has been historically (us)
PSM knows that every troublesome transition period
503 finds its own solutions in relating economic people
to social achievement.

1. Significance and importance of social protection

503 PSM considers that the society is responsible for
each of its members; therefore, our policy is di-
rected to build a complex system, capable to attain
achievement of all kind of citizens' interests.

4013 a) The whole system of the social policy, both
at the individual and collective level, can be a-
chieved only in conditions of various forms of
property ~~without~~ with full involvement of
mixed public property. The social policy, granting
503 the right and effective participation to work and
stable income, will become the basis of social
and individual protection. It is impossible to
701 suitably solve social protection only by ~~balancing~~
satisfying the split between some people's right for
property and some other people's

right to work and unemployment. As work is the main to-
-a for property, it will go further and make the main
701 direction in social protection and its policy. Lack
of protection for work, ^{work} access and conditions, means
701 lack of interest in both property and individual.

We also will promote classical social protection, the
503 specific to the market economy, ~~all~~ such as: unemploy-
ment fee, extralary, minimal income, etc. Only this
view can place the man in the center of development
allowing his not getting ~~affected~~ ^{affected} from this work
701 results, his being considered ~~a~~ a subject and not an
object, his active participation in the social reconstruc-
tion.

PSM will see to fight against poverty and will
503 work for establishing material and spiritual progress.

b) PSM will direct its social policy towards ~~raising~~
503 rising the living standards of the population.

2. Prevention of Social Risks

a) PSM will promote an information system and
701 adequate programmes for directing and repopulating
the unemployed ~~forces~~, at a national level. PSM
will initiate an economic system capable to equally
503 distribute the results of economic growth between
capital and labour.

b) PSM also militates for the customer's protection
403 and promotes introduction of international quality
standards. EQUAL BUT NOT LEVELLING DISTRIBUTION

3. Equal Distribution ~~but not levelling distribution~~

a) PSM recognizes ^{the} fundamental importance of in-
503 dividual contribution to the general social pro-
gress and believes in fair awards to each
one according to the respective awards potential.

503 Misunderstanding of the importance of individual, or collective creativeness, initiative and performance in the past led to severe levelling processes, which gave flat depress in sciences, technology and culture. PSM ~~emphasizes~~ stands for recognising and protecting the income generated by social useful activity quantum per each member of the society. New criteria in evaluating everyone's activity are needed; real promotion of values must be required, thus motivating everybody to participate with all his physical and intellectual potentials in the social activity, in order not only to assure his own protection but to work for the general progress.

503 b) PSM social policy is based on the principle of solidarity and co-operation, its main goals being directed 705 on the protection of handicap, children and unable 706 to-work people.

4. Work places granted.

701 a) Granting work places is a high social obligation under the circumstances of getting to a real social progress. PSM stands for special programmes for 701 integrating labour forces in rural and urban areas and displaying facilities for young people to work in less attractive areas.

701 b) Gradually, adequate economic and investment systems will be established in order to provide 706 work places for all graduates and graduate students as well as specific work places for women.

701 c) As work is the basic element in human life we must see to assure better conditions to it. We must promote new non-polluting technology and hygienic means to rise the health standards of the population.

5) The Social Service

- a) PSM stands for free social service in: education, professional training and conversion of labour, health care, etc. for children, students, low income people and other special cases of low standard of life.
- b) Effective social protection for inevitable risks will be integrated into a proper system (for unemployed, physically and mentally injured persons, old age and children, large families, lonely women and others). The system will involve both income and social enterprises to offer effective work to those people.
- c) In order to set humane work relationships in the unions activity, ~~the~~ Representatives of the employees will participate in taking decisions and running the companies.

6. Guarantees for social protection

- a) PSM militates for a new organizing and legal system ~~that~~ able to relate the human life to the level and requests of economic development.
- b) PSM states that the social protection belongs to the public administration, to all economic agents and local administrations, as well as to charity organizations of the local communities, which should be well informed in matters of social needs of the people in the area.

7. The Unions, defenders of working people

- a) PSM states that the unions play an essential part in promoting the legitimate interests of the employees. PSM will get wider cooperation from these unions through representing their social requests in relation with administrative boards, public administration, and Government, especially

7-1 b) PSM, as a party of the working people, is a true
7-1 supporter and authentic defender of the role and
interests of unions. There is an identification
of goals between PSM and unions, through
7-1 years of common historical existence and fight
for social protection. We respect their independence
in reference with the political parties and think
7-1 they have the right to lead their own fight
and strategy. We also support their unity in
7-1 action.

8. Housing construction

5-4 a) Housing construction was one of the main
realization in the postwar Romanian history.
4-11 b) We appreciate privatization of public
housing stock for this period. Still, we are
4-13 against total privatization of housing stock
as most of the inhabitants are actual tenants.
4-13 The tenants with low income will not be forced
to buy their apartments. Altogether, rents must
4-12 keep within reasonable limits and stay acces-
sible ~~to~~ to modest people. Privatization must
4-13 follow progress in accumulation of income
on behalf of the population. Any reason for
5-4 privatization must observe the principle of
getting funds for continuing investment
in housing construction.
5-4 c) Abandoning investments in housing was
a deep error, with unpredictable effects
over the population. The public central and
5-4 local administration, together with the economic
agents must invest in housing for young or
displaced people, devoid of financial means.

IV Civil Society and the Rule of Law

- 201 PSM stands for the liberty of manifestation
203 and promoting the civil society related to the demo-
cratic construction and functioning of the Rule of Law
based on the respect for human rights and the indi-
vidual's central role in organizing and
leading a social life. It is a constitutional duty of
the Romanian public administration to provide
201 real assurance for the free manifestation of the human
rights, according to international standards, in Romania.

The State

- 203 a) The state must be based on the principle of
separation of powers - legislative, executive, justice-
with necessary supremacy of the legislative over the
other two. In all main economic social and political
203 issues the solutions adopted will be bound to the
law, as an ~~expression~~ expression of the public institution
activity.
- 503 b) The state must be, in all conditions, a means
and instrument, perfectible and adaptable, to
achieve major social commitments, of ~~meeting~~
devotion to equal satisfaction of the citizens ~~the~~
~~interests~~ interests and active participation in demo-
cratization of the whole country's life -
- 203 c) The ~~form~~ form will be the presidential republic;
strictly ~~determined~~ determined prerogatives of the
203 President's prerogatives will be established the
may be can - under the control of the Parlia-
ment - adequately influence executive decision
with essential home and foreign policy and
laws.

2031 The President will effectively run the Supreme Defense Council, thus assuring stability and prestige of the military institution and placing the army under this command in special national and international events.

2. Law System

203 The law system must take up with the traditions in our country, include specific regulations for the present times, the dynamics of our further development, grant the private property individual owners' association and public property in key positions of our national economy. The laws will guarantee the citizens' rights and stipulate their obligations, derived from the qualification as Romanian citizens. We will emphasize upon equal rights for everybody, no discrimination being operated on nationality, social position or religious faith.

203 b) The law system will guarantee supremacy of Law and the laws will be applied by the executive power, which is also enabled to deal with administration of public economy and foreign policy.

203 c) Legislators will thoroughly observe the law and justices will be given inamovibility. The Supreme Court, The Appeal Courts and ordinary Courts will be strictly subordinated to public administration.

204 d) PSM considers that it is necessary to adopt firm laws, to establish strong courts, in order to eradicate fraud, corruption, delinquency and crime, to defend the life and property of citizens and preserve public property, to assure normal activity, peace, stability and national security.

The personal estate of high officials and other public
304 clerks estate will be checked by the law, members
of Parliament included.

3. Local administration

302 a) PSM stands for a local administration subor-
dinated to the central public administration
institutions, still preserving their autonomy and
right to handle funds. The first step towards
304 establishing these structures will be the local
elections, which will assure eradication of chaos
and corruption at the local level.

301 b) During the privatization process we think it
suitable to transfer a part of the national public
property to the local public property, according to
its local importance. According to PSM opinion
The local councils have to represent the gov-
ernment and all other public institutions in territory
with respect to the law, as their members will
be elected directly and nominally and will repre-
301 sent the will of the local population and will be
charged with the creation of work, development of finance and growth of the standard of life.

301 c) Prerogatives of local councils, as elected struc-
tures, and those of the prefects will be precise-
ly determined, the way the central public admin-
istration interferes only in case of breaking the
laws.

4. Youths and Women

706 a) PSM considers the young people to be the
future power in our country, therefore it militates
to attract them to the socialist ideals and
practice and will act, as a national party, for
their instruction in matters of patriotism and
national dignity, responsibility to the country and
601 its future.

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b) PSM will see that young people, no matter how wealthy their parents are, get equal chances in instruction and life, according to their skills and personal efforts. The government and other public institutions will protect young people and young families, providing new work places and restricting youths' unemployment.

c) Through equal chances for work, life and free travelling outside the country, we expect emigration with young people to stop and their activity to involve in reconstruction of our country.

d) PSM will encourage without really patronizing, establishing clubs, societies, youths organizations where these young people should find their own ways to keep in touch with the national and universal values and express themselves without discrimination based on philosophical, ideological or religious views.

e) PSM will militate for a new statute of women who represent more than half of the population - in social and political life. We recognize the fact that, in the post war period, the women have reached to equal rights with men and have been always considered equal to men in the Romanian society.

f) After December 22nd this statute has rather faltered and a feeling of distrust and reluctance towards women has appeared, although there is no reason for it. PSM will militate, according to the international tendencies of women emancipation, for promoting women into positions of responsibility.

g) The public administration will have to establish a special protection system for working women, in order to allow them to concentrate upon their family duties.

5. National minorities

a) Taking into consideration the fact that Romania is a national unitary state, sovereign and independent, permanently lived in by a majority of Romanian origin population, PSM will promote equal rights for all nationalities and majority altogether.

b) It is well-known that, during our cumulative historical existence, we have lived, worked and suffered together with many other nationalities - Bulgarians, Germans, Poles, Jews, Armenians, Tatars, Turks, Moravians and others - They all have recognized the Romanians as industrious, peaceful, humane, tolerant, hospitable and right people, open to common life and other people's understanding. Of course, the history of this common life in common wasn't totally deprived of conflicts which were always rejected by the rational, democratic forces among Romanians and minorities. Chauvinism and nationalism, hate, dissensions and inter ethnic conflicts, calumny and abuse of the national feeling and values were always the fertile prerogatives of nationalist forces, many a time manipulated from outside, by forces interested in breaking the Romanian unity.

c) Firmly stating equal rights for all Romanian citizens, PSM also states equal obligations for all of them, according to the Constitution, no national community being privileged. Liberty, equality, the right for a national identity are granted according to the Constitution. The Romanian language, as an official language all over the Romanian Territory, is considered to be the fundamental means of communication. Our party also respects the right of the national minorities to teach in their mother tongue to develop their national culture in connection with their origin countries, according to the international treaties.

d) According to the traditions of the Romanian socialist movement, PSM will assure to all its members, without any discrimination, equal rights and obligations and hopes that the working people of all minorities will join its ideology and will fully involve into social, economic and political life in our country.

e) As every left socialist party, preoccupied with achieving the ideals of freedom, social and national justice, in equity and independence of our country, equity and truth, respect to work, as a true creative source of material and spiritual values, PSM firmly rejects any kind of racism, chauvinism, revisionism, antisemitism, xenophobia, any extremist or national exclusivism coming from anywhere, embracing all these phenomena as degrading

and humiliating to the human race and a permanent source for interethnic fights, a divisive means to shake people distant from the major preoccupations in reconstructing the country.

f) PSM considers that defending the country territory, unity and independence, is a major right and obligation altogether for every Romanian citizen, of any national origin.

6. Defense of the country, public order and public security.

104 a) Highly appreciating ~~the past victories~~ its glorious past, ~~the~~ PSM considers the Army to be now a major element in patriotic education, cultivation of the national conscience, social stability and national equilibrium, guarantee for the defense of national interests and territorial integrity, of independence and sovereignty.

104 b) PSM will promote new equipment, modern war device and increase prestige of our army.

605 c) PSM will see to establish a legal, political moral and material system for the public order forces - police, military police, border security and customs security, fire force, financial guard and other - to do their duty in conditions of perfect honesty, firmness and responsibility in order to assure peace and security of personal and public property.

605 to fight against crime, corruption, beggary and prostitution, theft and destruction of public and private property.

d) PSM stands for establishing national specific security systems to fight against spies, terrorism and watch our national peace and our citizens' doing their duty to assure the achievement of vital Romanian interests. These systems ^{must} have no political feature, must keep away from any personal or public political influence. They must work only for preserving and defending national security.

7. Religion and Church

a) We, socialists, have always recognized importance and social role of the Church. During our troubled history, the church has always been a main element in: preserving culture, faith, christian morals, Romanian language, promoting the ideas of peace, equity and justice, protection of the poor and national public interests.

b) According to reasons above, PSM will co-operate with the orthodox, greek-catholic, roman-catholic, all other cults, churches, promoting dignifying and fair principles regarding work, honesty and peaceful co-existence, respect and good faith, defense of Romanian national interests.

c) Reciprocal respect, tolerance and loyalty should be promoted in relationship among cults, in order to make them restore their traditional role in propagating moral ideal and patriotic feelings among the Romanian people.

d) According to the laic principles of the socialist ideology and practice, PSM considers that the church should be separated in

power from the public administration, preserving its
204 autonomy, except for those activities contrary to
the Constitution and country laws or injuring
the citizens health.

V. Cultural policy

PSM highly appreciates creation of values,
means of conveying them, modelling role of cul-
502 ture and will firmly promote culture in Ro-
mania. Cultural progress comes from the hu-
man need of perfection, self-overcoming and
feeling for freedom, as the degree of individual
freedom and social liberty is fully reflected
502 in the quality, value and level of cultural
creation. Culture enriches and purifies, educate
and strengthens the power of action and deci-
502 sion, sharpens the evaluation and observation
spirit, and that is why it rejects any form
of stagnation and rigidity, control and totali-
tarian and opportunistic interferences. Natio-
502 nal culture, in its genuine value, including
our whole spiritual heritage, can be an
important ~~link~~ element for the people's cohesion,
the guarantee of national identity and specifi-
city. Permanent dialogue will be establish
502 with universal values to allow spiritual
relationship, understanding and cooperation
with all peoples in the world.

VI. Science

411 a) PSM is highly interested in promoting the
Romanian science as in conditions of a mo-
dern world, of human civilization in general,
only science can provide a proper basis to social
and economic life.

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107 PSM will promote integration of the Romanian team to the international scientific circuit.

411 b) Scientific and technologic research must concentrate now upon reorganizing the Romanian economic system, in order to make it function normally and create new ~~new~~ jobs for people.

411 c) Applied research and technological research will be most supported in the times to come.

411 The statute of research staff will be improved in order to stop brain exile.

506 Social sciences (philosophy, political economic science, sociology, history, political economy, aesthetics, psychology, law, etc) will be encouraged as a field less submitted to ideological interference and less deprived of actual realizations.

2. Education

506 a) PSM takes special care of education, as a formative system and stands for generalization of the 12 degree education system, adequate professional training added.

506 b) PSM militates for improvement of educational programmes, according to new modern achievements in science and use for dynamic features in development in our new society.

506 c) We stand for generalized mass-education, mostly public and free, especially for the poor people to get free access to it, laic, open to all ideas, in good material conditions, with competent teachers involved.

506 We claim for autonomy with universities, institutions, scholars ships home and abroad, post-universitarian courses, etc, in order to get proper valorification of our intelligence potentials.

3. Arts

- 502 a) Arts have always been directly related to
502 social life, still preserving its authorship. We
502 consider it to be the superior way of human expres-
sion in spiritual life.
- 502 b) PSM will assure to arts a specific legal and
material system in order to stimulate and improve
its climate and will promote real stimulation
of values and integration to the world's artistic
system.
- 502 c) We will support genuine artistic creation, non-
tied by the national universe of feeling and
thought. We will preserve folklore, ~~folk~~ folk arts
inheritance of the past generations, and we hope
502 to make them a source of inspiration for the
new generations. We also stand for an objective
realistic analysis of the cultural realizations in
the past 45 years in order to preserve what real
502 was creative and of any artistic value in it,
not letting it be degraded and abused for political
reasons.
- 502 d) PSM will assure the best conditions for access &
information of the artists to arts in international
circuit to international ~~art~~ exchanges.
- 502 e) We stand for improvement of material basis
in arts - through public and private contributions
for free access to it for every professional or
amateur artists, in order to get superior value
502 of the wide Romanian creative potential
and deeper penetration of arts in social con-
science, which will strengthen the feelings of
freedom and dignity with the whole Romanian
people.
- 502 f) PSM includes into the Romanian culture
work and personalities of Romanian origin
outside the country, to the extent that any of
these values, promoting progress, is integrated into
the national system.

502 9) We must prevent degrading arts through the
effects of the market economy. PSM highly
502 appreciates the role of intellectuals and artists
in society and salutes their presence among its
members.

4. mass media

201 a) PSM considers that every citizen in Romania
has a right of free expressing his opinions, in
201 words, writing and image and the right of free
access to any kind of national or international
information system. Freedom of mass media and
201 information must be granted without any control
but for his own mind's one, exercised through his
201 dignity and moral responsibility, political and
justice responsibility included.

201 b) According to PSM, mass media - press, radio,
TV, and others - should inform the public of
union and practice the civic control over the society
201 mass-media represents the way through which
legal protection against abusive decision, excess and
201 personal interests, is achieved.

203 c) Mass-media must respect the Constitution and
laws of the country, national and international
203 public opinion and ~~the~~ have to assume full
responsibility for authenticity of the information
203 published. Mass-media must reject any discrimi-
201 nation. Any person can reply to abuse in press
201 and contest the information ingering him.

601 d) PSM thinks that the moral-professional code of
the journalist should forbid blaming the nation
601 and the country, instigation to conflicts and war,
national hate, racism and religious discrimination,
607 promotion, instigating to violence and ethnic
603 fights as well as manifestations of indecency, obscen-
and against moral rules.

5. Democratization of culture

- 502 a) PSM keeps intellectuals in high esteem and thinks that they should play a great part in attracting the mass of people towards cultural values. We also will promote wide spread for the national spiritual and universal values among the working people.
- 502 b) According to our opinion, mass culture is no inferior cultural species, but an expression of democratization of culture.
- 502 c) PSM stands for rapid reintegration into the cultural life of all cultural home, libraries, cultural houses in the country side and little towns, in order to re-establish their role in spreading culture.
- 502 d) PSM stands for public administration support in these institutions.
- 502 e) PSM sees these cultural local institutions as elements of permanent education among common people.

B Sports

- 502 a) Sports is an element of culture, directly linked to quality of life, standard of civilization and degree of instruction. PSM will continue the traditions of the socialist movement in Romania regarding the mass-sports activities. We also promote performance to get prestige for our country.
- 601 b) We think that regress in Romanian mass and performance sport after 1990 is harmful to the country development. We therefore think that the public administration should involve in redeeming it.

VI Foreign policy

- a) PSM thinks that Romania must lead world foreign policies based on reason and national interests.

- 107 representing the whole nation's will. Planning, on
partisan interests, the international activities pre-
moting ^{our} national interests, appealing to forces in-
107 tered in isolating Romania are extremely harmful
to the country and politically disgrace their author.
- b) The foreign policy must fully realize integrating
Romania into the new economic, political and
107 cultural European structures, getting support for
the transition period. Discrimination practiced
to some East Europe states, establishing a group
of privileged countries out of them, conditioning
1023 of aid and normal relationship on political
views imposed from outside, these are all
breakings to the laws of international devel-
opment and we must fight against them.
- c) Relationships have to be re-established with
107 Western countries, according to our pre-war
traditions but we have also to keep in mind
1013 permanent cooperation with our neighbours
107 and all other democratic countries.
- d) A positive contribution to realization of new
Europe is to be seen in economic and
107 political agreements among the Danube river
basin countries (The Rhein - Danube network).
- e) Romania will militate in its foreign policy
107 for equal rights for all countries, sovereignty
107 and independence, in order to get proper security
107 in the world, eliminate the development and

- f) PSM stands for cooperation with neighbour
countries, Western countries and NATO

- g) In achieving its ideals, Romania needs support from all its friends abroad, mainly from the Romanians outside the country. We wish that Romanians in the diaspora, share the loyalty to their countries of adoption with loyalty to their mother country, promoting the Romanian culture and getting as much support as they can for the needs of their country. On the other side, Romania will have to look for the Romanian population's needs, outside the country, to support them in preserving their national identity and culture.
- h) We also hope that the Romanian new policy will make way to liquidation of the unjust effects of the Ribbentrop Molotov pact.
- i) PSM will promote relationship with socialist, communist, social-democratic, working parties and any other democratic movements in other countries.
